

ORDINANCE NUMBER 07 - 20

ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE VII, TRAFFIC CODE,
CHAPTER 70, GENERAL PROVISIONS, BY ADDING A NEW
SECTION 70.07, FOURTH STREET RESIDENTIAL PARKING

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of East Dundee having determined that it is in the best interests of the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Village of East Dundee that Title VII, **Traffic Code**, Chapter 70, **General Provisions** be amended by adding a new Section 70.07, **Fourth Street Residential Parking**.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

Section One. That Title VII, **Traffic Code**, Chapter 70, **General Provisions** of the Village of East Dundee Code of Ordinances is hereby amended by adding a new **Section 70.07, Fourth Street Residential Parking** as follows:

70.07 **Fourth Street Residential Parking**

(A) There are hereby established and made available to the persons set forth herein a maximum of ten (10) "4th Street Residential Parking Permits." Where an authorized "4th Street Residential Parking Permits" is available, upon payment, at the rate set forth in the Annual Fee Schedule, by a resident of any residential dwelling unit or business located in the 300 block of River Street in the Village of East Dundee, the person making such payment shall receive a "4th Street Residential Parking Permits" permit which shall allow, without any further payment, such person to park the motor vehicle for which the permit has been issued on 4th Street overnight.

(B) No more than two (2) such "4th Street Residential Parking Permits " shall be issued per residential dwelling unit.

Section Two. Severability. If any section, paragraph or provision of this ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the validity or unenforceability of such section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this ordinance.

Section Three. Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

Section Four. Publication. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
