

**RESOLUTION NUMBER 18 -08**

**RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE ROUTE 72  
TRANSPORTATION ENHANCEMENT PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of East Dundee is a home rule unit of local government under and pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs, including but not limited to the power to regulate for the protection of the public health, safety, morals, and welfare; and

**WHEREAS**, it is deemed necessary and desirable for the Village of East Dundee to authorize and approve the Resolution IDOT has requested that the Village provide demonstrating the Village's support for a project that the Illinois Department of Transportation provides up to 80% reimbursement funding for transportation enhancement projects to local governments on a competitive basis through the Illinois Transportation Enhancement and Green Streets Programs; and

**WHEREAS**, the Village has put substantial effort into the development of the Downtown Revitalization Plan, the Dundee Crossings economic development initiative, and the Route 72 Corridor Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the enhancements identified in the Route 72 Corridor Plan will greatly benefit the Village of East Dundee and the region by:

- Improving the bicycle and pedestrian connection for the region's residents to employment, shopping and recreation centers,
- Aesthetically improving the streetscape at Dundee Crossings,
- Increasing the quantity of street trees and vegetation along Route 72,
- Serving as a critical implementation step to realizing the Village's vision of East Dundee as an intermodal Village; and
- Encouraging mixed-use redevelopment at Dundee Crossings
