### **EAST DUNDEE VILLAGE PRESIDENT/LIQUOR COMMISSIONER LAEL MILLER SIGNS EXECUTIVE ORDER 20-03 MODIFYING VILLAGE-ISSUED LIQUOR LICENSE AND VIDEO GAMING FEES**

Dear Liquor Licensee,

On April 27, 2020, Village of East Dundee President Lael Miller declared a Continued State of Emergency in the Village of East Dundee to best protect the public's health, safety and welfare regarding the COVID-19 pandemic. As the State continues with the Governor's Stay-At-Home Order through at least May 30, 2020, the Village understands that these are unprecedented times resulting in unfortunate impacts to our local businesses and economy. With liquor license and video gaming permit renewals approaching, the Village understands the financial impact that this could have on businesses at this time. In effort to temporarily alleviate financial impacts to these businesses, President Miller has signed Executive Order 20-03 modifying the expiration dates for all Village-issued liquor licenses and video gaming permits that are in effect as of April 27, 2020 to be extended from June 30, 2020 to September 30, 2020. Furthermore, the cost of liquor license and video gaming fees renewed and issued by the Village on October 1, 2020 shall be prorated at 75%. For example, if your annual liquor license fee is \$2,000, your prorated fee will be \$1,500. All video gaming licenses will be prorated to a fee of \$750 and \$187.50/terminal.

The Village understands that these are tough times, but would like to reiterate the seriousness of COVID-19 and importance of continuing to follow the guidance set forth by the State through the Stay-At-Home Order and social distancing guidelines. We appreciate your partnership in this fight against this pandemic, and as the Village receives additional updates and guidance on the COVID-19 response, we will make sure to share that information with each of you. We hope that you and your families continue to be safe and healthy!
