

ORDINANCE NUMBER 19 - 22

AN ORDINANCE OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE,
COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS
AMENDING STORMWATER CONTROL AND DETENTION REGULATIONS
(Kane County Stormwater Management Ordinance)

WHEREAS, the Village of East Dundee ("Village") is a home rule unit of local government pursuant to Section 6 of Article VII of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and has the authority to exercise any power and perform any function pertaining to its government and affairs; and

WHEREAS, Kane County has recently adopted a revised Stormwater Management Ordinance (hereinafter "SMO") effective June 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village have deemed it to be in the best interest of the Village that the Village Code be amended to reflect the revised SMO;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE VILLAGE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Each Whereas paragraph above is incorporated by reference into this Section 1 and made a part hereof as material and operative provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 2: Village Code Amendment. That Section 154.01, Regulations Adopted, of the Village Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

"The regulations of the Kane County Stormwater Management Ordinance, as amended from time to time, are hereby adopted by reference as the Village of East Dundee Storm Water Ordinance (hereafter the "Stormwater Management Ordinance")."

SECTION 3: Village Code Amendment. That Section 154.02, Amendments to the Kane County Stormwater Management Ordinance, of the Village Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

(A) Article IV chapter 9-83 (C) of the Stormwater Management Ordinance shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

"The minor stormwater systems shall be sized to convey the runoff from the tributary watershed under fully developed conditions for the 10 year storm event. Street inlet capacity shall be provided such that the depth of ponding does not exceed 6 inches nor the width of ponding exceed 8 feet from the

face of curb.”

(B) Article IV Chapter 9-84 (J) of the Stormwater Management Ordinance shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

“Parking lots may be utilized to provide supplementary site runoff storage volume. The maximum stormwater ponding in any parking area shall not exceed six inches in depth and shall not remain flooded for more than four hours. Parking lots shall be used only as supplementary storage for storms exceeding the ten-year recurrence interval. They shall be located such that the parking lot is a minimum of two feet above the bottom of the primary detention basin.”

SECTION 4: Village Code Amendment. That Section 154.08, Performance Security, of the Village Code is hereby deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:

“The performance security shall be the greater of the requirements found in Article VIII Chapter 9-203 of the Kane County Stormwater Management Ordinance and Section §155.095 of the Village's Subdivision Ordinance.”

SECTION 5: Severability. If any Section, paragraph or provision of this Ordinance shall be held to be invalid or unenforceable for any reason, the invalidity or unenforceability of such Section, paragraph or provision shall not affect any of the remaining provisions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 6: Repeal. All ordinances, resolutions, motions or parts thereof in conflict herewith shall be and the same are hereby repealed.

SECTION 7: Effect. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect forthwith upon its adoption, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.


