

**RESOLUTION NO. 07 - 11**

**RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE KANE COUNTY  
NATURAL HAZARDS MITIGATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Village of East Dundee is subject to flooding, tornadoes, winter storms and other natural hazards that can damage persons and property, close businesses, disrupt traffic and present a public health and safety hazard; and

**WHEREAS**, the "Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan" for Kane County has been required by FEMA since November 2003 in support of state and/or federal mitigation grant funding; and

**WHEREAS**, the County residents have been invited to participate in the plan update process and the updated plan has been circulated for review to state and regional agencies and has been supported by those reviewers; and

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency requires that the Kane County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plane be updated every five years; and

**WHEREAS**, the "Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan", as revised in 2009, has been widely circulated for review by residents and federal, state and regional agencies and has been supported by those reviewers; and the Village of East Dundee has reviewed same and finds that adoption of said Plan by the Village, in the form as approved by the County Board of Kane County, Illinois on December 8, 2009, by Resolution No.09-470 is in the best interests of the Village; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF EAST DUNDEE, COOK AND KANE COUNTIES, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section One:** The "Kane County Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan" (2009 Update) in the form as approved by the Kane county Board on December 8, 2009, by Resolution No.09-470 , is hereby adopted by reference, in its entirety, as the official Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan of the Village of East Dundee.

**Section Two:** The Natural Hazards Mitigation Plan, as adopted, identifies a series of action items. The following action items are hereby assigned to the designated department of the Village. The designated department shall ensure that the action item is implemented by the deadline set forth in the Mitigation Plan, subject to fiscal and staff time constraints.

1. Building Code Improvements: Building Department.
2. Improved Code Enforcement: Building Department.
3. Review of Plans and Development Regulations: Building Department.
4. Facility Audits: Public Works Department.
5. Retrofitting Incentives: Administration Department.
6. Repetitive Loss Projects: Administration Development.
7. Drainage Maintenance: Public Works Department.
8. Urban Forestry: Public Works Department.
9. Flood Threat Recognition: Engineering Department.
10. Improved Emergency Response: Administration Department.
11. Flood Control Projects: Engineering Department.
12. Hazard Mitigation Materials: Fire Department.
13. Outreach Projects: Administration Department.
14. Property Protection References: Building Department.
15. Community Rating System: Administration Department.

**Section Three:** The Village Administrator, or such other person as may be determined by the Village of East Dundee, is hereby appointed as the Village's representative on the Kane County Mitigation Coordinating Committee. The departments charged with plan implementation in Section 2 shall keep the representative advised of their progress and recommendations on implementing the action items.

**Section Four:** This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its passage, presentation and approval according to law.
