GENERAL VILLAGE COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES

Monday, June 7th, 2010

Chairman Michael Ruffulo called the meeting to order at 5:30pm... In attendance were Village Trustee Paul VanOstenbridge, Village Trustee John Cichowski, and Chief of Police Terry Mee.

There was no audience business.

The first item under old business was Review of the Village Policy Manual; we agreed to address this at the next meeting.

The second item under old business was a discussion of "pawn shop regulations" for certain business types. Chief Mee reiterated that businesses such as "Cash for Gold" have no special regulations regarding their operation, nor did he feel they should. The Committee agreed to research this item and keep it on the agenda.

Next under old business was review of sign ordinance, especially as it relates to certain window area and times of operation. Again, the Committee agreed to research this item and keep it on the agenda.

The next item discussed was review of the parking ordinance, specifically addressing whether all vehicles had to be parked on paved surfaces. It was determined that such an ordinance would not be feasible at this time due to the fact that certain residences have gravel driveways.

Last item under old business was "discussion of Village Board and P&Z Minutes". This item was requested by President Bartels, and since he was not present, was tabled.

The only item under new business was Chairman Ruffulo's introduction of legislation to require all medical facilities in the Village to reserve a minimum of two parking spaces to accommodate handicapped persons. After some discussion, a motion was made by Trustee VanOstenbridge, seconded by Trustee Cichowski, to send this matter to the full Village Board and Attorney for proper verbiage and approval. Motion carried 3-0.

Motion to adjourn at 6:55pm by VanOstenbridge/Cichowski. Approved 3-0.
