

WATER USE RESTRICTION POLICY

The Village recognizes that our residents expect and deserve a reliable system that provides water of the highest quality. In order to meet the current and future demands of our residents the Village of West Dundee has adopted water conservation measures regarding outside water usage.

The Village has installed signs at 15 different locations to keep residents informed of any restrictions on outside water use. These signs have a color-coded plaque as follows:

GREEN “CONSERVATION”

Landscape and lawn watering permitted. Residents are asked during this period to voluntarily conserve water.

YELLOW “EVEN/ODD”

Property owners with an **EVEN** numbered address may water lawns on **EVEN** numbered days and property owners with an **ODD** numbered address may water their lawns on **ODD** numbered days. Outside water use such as washing cars, filling pools, watering with a hand-held hose, etc is restricted to your odd/even day address. When the yellow status is in effect, property owners should only water as necessary to avoid more stringent restrictions.

ORANGE “EVEN/ODD”

Property owners with an **EVEN** numbered address may water from 6am-9am and from 6pm -9pm **only** on **EVEN** numbered days and property owners with an **ODD** numbered address may water from 6am-9am and from 6pm-9pm **only** on **ODD** numbered days.

RED “NO OUTSIDE USAGE”

No outside water usage is permitted. Lawn sprinklers, landscape watering with a hand-held hose, washing cars, filling pools or other forms of outside water usage is strictly prohibited.
