**A. Daily Liquor Permit Request- Knights of Columbus Siena Council St. Patrick's Dinner Dance, March 7, 2020**

Manager Cavallaro said this is a Daily Liquor Permit request from St. Catherine of Siena's Knights of Columbus for their annual St. Patrick's Benefit Dinner Dance on Saturday, March 7, 2020.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit for the annual St. Patrick's Benefit Dinner Dance on Saturday, March 7, 2020 from 6:00 to 11:00 pm at St. Catherine of Siena, located at 845 W. **B. Consideration of Establishing a Limit to the Number of Video Gaming Terminals Per Establishment**

Manager Cavallaro said the Village has received a number of requests as it relates to recent changes in the State statute regarding Video Gaming and the State of Illinois' authorization to increase the allowable number of gaming machines per establishment by one, from the original number of five (5) to six (6).

Manager Cavallaro said Staff is recommending that we formally alter the regulation within the Municipal Code specifying the number of games per establishment shall be limited to a maximum of five (5) machines.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend adoption of an Ordinance Amending Title 6, Chapter 1, Section 18, Video Gaming, of the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, establishing the Number of Allowable Video Gaming Devices per Establishment to no more than five (5). Upon roll call, motion was approved.
