IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

- A. Liquor License Hearing Continuation**
Bikini Bottom Bar, 105-107 W. Main Street

Police Chief Wieteska said that he has had productive discussions with the owners of Bikini Bottom Bar and has come up with a mutually agreeable plan for improvements to address the issues of concern.

He said that the main objective of video surveillance is being addressed, but is still waiting for the final proposal as well as some other issues that need to be worked out.

He added that there are doorman on Friday and Saturday nights and all patrons' IDs are scanned.

He asked the Commission to provide direction for counsel to put together a draft agreement.

Attorney Orr said a continuance for thirty (30) days until the July 16, 2018 meeting to present a draft agreement is in order.

Chief Wieteska said that he would like to have the Police Department to have accessibility to the proposed security cameras in this draft agreement.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to approve a continuance of the Liquor License Hearing to July 16, 2018. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**B. Daily Liquor Permit Request

Manager Cavallaro said this is a Special Event Application and Daily Liquor Permit Request from the VFW for a Crawfish Boil to be held on July 14, 2018.

He said outdoor festivities and consumption of alcohol is requested from 9:00 am -9:00 pm for the event. He added the VFW wishes to allow alcohol to be consumed outside within a fenced in area, which only includes the VFW parking lot. There are no street closures being requested.

He said there will be outside amplification of music from 2:00 pm to 6:00 pm.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit Request for VFW Post 2298, located at 117 S. First Street, for a Crawfish Boil to be held on Saturday, July 14, 2018. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

NAYS: None


V. MISCELLANEOUS: There was none.


VI. ADJOURNMENT:
