I. CALL TO ORDER:

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. October 21, 2013

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to approve the Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes of October 21, 2013. Upon roll call, motion was unanimous.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Class B License Request – Blue Line Bar & Grill
801 Weseman Drive

Manager Cavallaro explained that this application represents a new ownership and a change in name for the concession facilities at the Leafs Ice Center.

Mr. George Othon, 36W669 Crane Road, St. Charles, IL addressed the Board, explaining that he currently owns and operates two restaurants both named Blue Line & Grill in Addison and Woodridge. Both these restaurants have been in operation for several years and both are operated within an Ice Hockey complex. He said his restaurants have a loyal customer base and are a popular restaurant associated with Ice Rinks.

Mr. George Othon plans to manage Blue Line & Grill in West Dundee along with the assistance of one of the managers from one of the other restaurants. He said that initially, there will counter service in the eatery downstairs and plans for a beer garden on the second floor in the future.

Mr. Othon said he along with his managers are BASSETT certified and that he plans to deliver food within a ten (10) mile radius without charge.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend the Finding of Fact be adopted and a Class B liquor license be issued for the establishment known as Blue Line Bar and Grill,, located at 801 Weseman Drive, pursuant to the conditions noted. Upon roll call, motion was unanimous.

**B. Class C License Request
Fast & Easy
1997 Huntley Road**

Manager Cavallaro said this is a request for a Class C liquor license for Fast & Easy, a convenience store which will be located at Tartans Crossings shopping plaza.

Mr. Ahmad Azmi explained to the Commissioners that he is opening a convenience store (quick mart) at 1997 Huntley Road. He told the Commissioners that he has extensive experience managing retail establishments, will actively manage this store himself and plans to stock convenience type items, lottery tickets, cigarettes and liquor.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to adopt the Finding of Fact and approve a Class C Liquor License to Mr. Ahmad Azmi for the establishment known as Fast & Easy, located at 1997 Huntley Road. Upon roll call, motion was approved.
