A. Class A Liquor License Application
West End Restaurant and Bar, 629 S. Eighth Street

Mr. Steve Minginas presented the liquor license request for West End Restaurant and Bar, a new dining establishment that will be located at 629 S. Eighth Street.

Mr. Minginas advised that the focus of the establishment will be as a family restaurant with a variety of menu items. The existing separate bar area will be utilized as a sports bar environment with televisions, draft beers and well drinks. The establishment will be run by Mr. Minginas and his wife, Sandy (Alexandra). Mr. and Mrs. Minginas have previous experience operating a Greek restaurant in Arlington Heights.

Pursuant the Finding of Fact, all required documentation has been received and reviewed and the license fee submitted. Lieutenant Riggle confirmed that fingerprinting and background checks have been completed satisfactorily.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Osth to adopt the six-point Finding of Fact provided in Manager Cavallaro's memo dated July 19, 2012 and recommend to the Village Board the issuance of a Class A Liquor License for West End Restaurant and Bar located at 629 S.
