I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 5:50 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson. Commissioners Andy Yuscka and Pat Hanley were absent.

Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro, Village Attorney Kathleen Orr and Police Chief Andrew Wieteska and ten (10) people in the audience.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

President Nelson tabled the minutes of January 20, 2018 and February 19, 2018 to a future Local Liquor Meeting as there was no quorum.

Attorney Orr stated that the violators have been served with notices of the violations, have pleaded guilty and have agreed to pay the fines and court costs.

Attorney Orr read the Final Orders which were signed by all the aforementioned businesses, copies of which are attached hereto. She stated that the violators have agreed to a one day suspension and the payment of fines and costs. Manager Cavallaro said the one-day suspension is stayed for one (1) year, provided there are no further violations.
