**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

**A. January 6, 2014**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Chairman Nelson to approve the Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes of January 6, 2014. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. Video Gaming License Request – Tri City VFW Post 2298**

Manager Cavallaro said that the gaming license application and documentation have been submitted. He said Tri City VFW Post 2298 will use the services of G3 Gaming, LLC as their terminal operator.

**MOTION:** Moved by Chairman Nelson and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend the Finding of Fact be adopted for the issuance of a video gaming license to Tri City VFW Post 2298 at 117 South First Street for 3 machines. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**B. Video Gaming License Request – Dylan’s Pub**

Manager Cavallaro said that the gaming license application and documentation have been received and that Dylan’s will be using GEM Entertainment, LLC as their terminal operator for 5 machines.

Manager Cavallaro said that Chief Wieteska met with Mr. Mefta to discuss previous issues and that steps are being taken in the right direction in terms of addressing those issues. He said at this time the Police Department is now recommending the issuance of a video gaming permit.

**MOTION:** Moved by Chairman Nelson and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend the Finding of Fact be adopted for the issuance of a video gaming registration to Dylan’s Pub at 101 W. Main Street for 5 machines. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**C. Special Event/Daily Liquor Permit Request – St. Catherine of Siena, Irish Jig Jog**

Manager Cavallaro said this request is from St. Catherine of Siena for their annual Irish Jig Jog 5K race, to take place on March 15, 2014. He liquor privileges are being requested as the race no longer coincides with Irish Fest. He said sale and service of beer only is requested and consumption will be limited to the school gym.

Manager Cavallaro said there will be a reimbursement to the Village for police services to cover the race for 2 officers at 2 hours.

**MOTION:** Moved by Chairman Nelson and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend the approval of a Daily Liquor Permit Request and Special Event Application for the Irish Jig Jog 5K Race on March 15, 2014.
