

**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

**II. ROLL CALL:**

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson, Commissioners Andy Yuscka and Pat Hanley. Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro, Attorney John Brechin and approximately 15 people in the audience.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**A. January 18, 2016**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley approve the Minutes of the January 18, 2016 Local Liquor Control Commission Meeting. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. Daily Liquor Permit Applications - St. Catherine of Siena School, 845 W Main**

- 1. St. Patrick's Dinner Dance (Knights of Columbus) – March 5, 2016**
- 2. Paint & Sip – April 22, 2016**

Manager Cavallaro stated that both requests are for repeat events, held by St. Catherine Knights of Columbus and St. Catherine School, respectively. St. Catherine's has held several events for which a Daily Liquor Permit has been granted, and has a very positive history in this regard. Alcohol consumption for both events shall be limited to those 21 and over, consist of beer and wine only, and be restricted to the school gym.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend issuance of Daily Liquor Permits to St. Catherine of Siena, located at 845 W. Main, for St Patrick's Dinner Dance to be held on Saturday, March 5, 2016 from 6-11 pm, and for Paint & Sip to be held on Friday, April 22 from 6-11 pm. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**B. Daily Liquor Permit Application – Dooley's Irish Ale House, 98 W Main  
St. Patrick's Day Celebration – March 12, 2016**

Manager Cavallaro stated that Dooley's wishes to add to the St. Patrick's Day festivities with an outdoor event. He invited petitioner Matt Harrison to present his request.

Mr. Harrison explained that his desire is to close North First Street along the west side of Dooley's to vehicle traffic. Hard barricades would be used along the entrance to North First Street from Route 72, but access from the parking lot onto North First Street, north of the fenced-in area, will remain open to vehicle traffic, and the sidewalk on the west side of First Street would remain open to pedestrian traffic.

The area in which alcohol will be served would be enclosed with snow fencing and accessible only through Dooley's via the side entrance. Additional staff and security will be utilized, and wristbands issued to those 21 and over who wish to consume alcohol. The event will also include live music and outdoor food service, in addition to outdoor alcohol service.

Mr. Harrison also stated that this event will be Dooley's Grand Opening celebration, and that it is all weather dependent.

Per staff recommendation, the hours of the event and the Daily Liquor Permit would be limited to Noon to 5:00 pm. The street closure will be in effect earlier to facilitate set up, but will be reopened by 6:00 pm.

Manager Cavallaro noted that additional Police staff will be on duty based on the significant amount of activities that day, but not specifically assigned to Dooley's.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend issuance of a Daily Liquor Permit to Dooley's Irish Ale House, located at 98 W. Main, for their St Patrick's Day Celebration to be held on Saturday, March 12, 2016 from 12:00 pm to 5:00 pm. Upon roll call, motion was approved.
