I. CALL TO ORDER:

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. October 24, 2016

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Minutes of the October 24, 2016 Local Liquor Control Commission Meeting. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Class K Liquor License – Cinemark – 2000 Spring Hill Mall

Manager Cavallaro said this classification was recently adopted and is specifically designed to address the allowance of liquor privileges within a motion picture facility. He added that Cinemark has met all the requirements.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to adopt the Finding of Fact and issue a Class K liquor license to Cinemark USA, Inc. for their location at 2000 Spring Hill Mall, pursuant to the conditions noted, and to adopt an Ordinance Amending Alcoholic Liquor Regulations of the Municipal Code, Amending the Number of Allowed Liquor Licenses. Upon roll call, motion was approved.
