**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:20 pm.

**II. ROLL CALL:**

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson, and Commissioners Andy Yuscka and Pat Hanley.

Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro, Village Attorney Orr, Petitioner Mike Morrison and eight (8) people in the audience.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**A. September 11, 2017 Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Minutes of the September 11, 2017 Local Liquor Control Commission Meeting. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. The Chubby Bullfrog Bar & Grill - Change of Address / Transfer of Class A License**

Manager Cavallaro stated that The Chubby Bullfrog is preparing to open in their new location at Spring Hill Mall. To facilitate the continuation of their liquor and video gaming privileges, their existing Class A Liquor License and Video Gaming License must be formally transferred to the new address.

Additionally, The Chubby Bullfrog has requested to increase the number of allowed video gaming machines from four (4) to five (5).

Petitioner Mike Morrison stated that The Chubby Bullfrog anticipates applying for the updated Illinois Liquor License tomorrow and opening at Spring Hill Mall in early October.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to transfer the current Class A liquor license and their current Video Gaming License for The Chubby Bullfrog Bar & Grill from 1959 Huntley Road, West Dundee, Illinois, 60118 to 1494 Spring Hill Mall, West Dundee, Illinois, 60118, and to increase the number of allowed gaming terminals from four (4) to five (5), effective Tuesday, September 26, 2017. Upon roll call, motion was approved.
