**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

**II. ROLL CALL:**

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson, and Commissioners Pat Hanley and Andy Yuscka. Also present were Village Manager and Village Attorney Brechin. There were two (2) people in the audience.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**A. September 9, 2013**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes of September 9, 2013. Upon roll call, motion was approved unanimously.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. Video Gaming License Request – Bikini Bottom Bar & Grill**

Manager Cavallaro reviewed the application and Finding of Fact as outlined in staff's memo dated October 2, 2013, and recommended approval of the video gaming license request for Bikini Bottom Bar & Grill. He noted that this is the first video gaming license request submitted since the approval of video gaming by the Village Board earlier this year.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to adopt the Finding of Fact for the issuance of a video gaming license for up to 4 machines to Bikini Bottom Bar & Grill, Inc. for its establishment located at 105-107 W Main Street, and to recommend approval of this license to the Village Board. Upon roll call, motion was approved unanimously.

**V. MISCELLANEOUS:**

Commissioner Yuscka inquired whether the Commission should be renamed Local Liquor Control and Gaming Commission.
