

LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:06 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Nelson, Commissioners Yuscka and Hanley. Also present were Village Manager Cavallaro, Village Attorney Brechin, Chief Wieteska and five people in the audience.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES;

A. August 3, 2015

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the minutes of August 3, 2015 as presented. Upon roll call, motion was approved unanimously.

B. August 31, 2015

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to approve the minutes of August 31, 2015 as presented. Upon roll call, motion was approved unanimously.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Class A Liquor License Application
Dundee Sports Bar – 999 West Main Street

Mr. Jeff Dunham, owner of the Dundee Sports Bar is requesting a Class A liquor license for his establishment to be located at 999 W. Main Street.

Mr. Dunham said the Sports Bar will hold indoor events for several sports including gymnastics. He said these events will potentially bring in thousands of attendees who will utilize the restaurant and bar.

He said that the second part of his request is to obtain the license for the Halloween Haunted House which will be operating at 999 W. Main Street during the month of October. He explained that he has worked with the Police Department and will be hiring a police officer to work on the weekends. He said there is a large waiting area where attendees will congregate and he wants to serve beer and wine. There will be wristbands required for those over 21 and he has a security team to make sure there are no underage drinkers.

Chief Wieteska said he has little apprehension about the Haunted House and is comfortable with the plan. He said their security plan is good and that one West Dundee Police Officer will be on duty there from 8pm to 1am Friday and Saturday nights. All the servers of beer and wine have been Bassett certified and will follow the Bassett procedures. Drinks may only be consumed in the waiting area.

In answer to Commissioners questions, Mr. Corey Kelly, from the Dundee Sports Bar, said the haunted house is geared more to the 20 to 30 year olds, but expects to have high school age people there. He expects that there will be a half-hour to an hour wait to enter the Haunted House, so patrons will be steered to the open area where there are amusements.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to adopt the Finding of Fact as presented and issue a Class A liquor license for Dundee Sports Bar located at 999 W. Main Street, pursuant to the conditions noted. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**B. Daily Liquor Permit Application
St. Catherine of Siena School, Paint & Sip – October 9, 2015**

Manager Cavallaro said this is a fundraising event taking place Friday, October 9, 2015 at 7 pm at St. Catherine's School. He said while this is a new event, St. Catherine's has held previous events involving liquor privileges and has a good history within the community in that respect. He said alcohol will not be sold or provided by St. Catherine's directly, but brought on site by individual participants for their own consumption during the event. Consumption of alcohol will be limited to the school gym

St. Catherine's has arranged for taxi services to be available, should they be needed.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit Request to St. Catherine of Siena located at 845 W. Main for "Paint and Sip" to be held October 9, 2015. Upon roll call, motion was approved.
