I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:04 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

A. Class A Liquor License Request Bamboozels – 101 W. Main Street

Manager Cavallaro said that an application for a Class A liquor license has been received for a new liquor establishment known as Bamboozels to be located at 101 W. Main Street.

Ms. Diane Jacobs, who will be the sole owner of Bamboozels, addressed the Liquor Commission. She said it will be a family friendly restaurant and bar. The first floor will have half of it devoted to seating for families and the other half will have dart boards, high top tables and large screen TV's for viewing sporting events. She said the second floor will be an upscale "Fusion Lounge" offering soft seating and lounge chairs.

Ms. Jacobs said she would like to use a side window for carry out and walk up orders. No alcohol will be served at the walk-up location. She said they plan on opening sometime in August after all renovations are completed. She also said she is looking at both avenues of either leasing or owning the facility.

Chief Wieteska said the background check has been done and every thing is in order. He said Ms. Jacobs is Basset certified and that any employees handling the sale of alcohol must be Basset certified prior to the opening of the establishment.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Chairmen Nelson to adopt the Finding of Fact and issue a Class A liquor license for Bamboozels, located at 101 W. Main Street, pursuant to the conditions noted. Upon roll call motion, was approved.
