I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

A. Daily Liquor License Permit Request – St. Catherine of Siena – Fall Fest 10/6/13

Becky Pietraszewski presented this item to the Commission and gave an overview of the Fall Fest. She said liquor privileges for the event are being requested for the sale of beer and wine. She said ID's will be checked to confirm legal drinking age and a wristband will be provided to all who will be consuming alcohol.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Special Event Application and Daily Liquor Permit for St. Catherine of Siena for their Fall Fest to take place on October 6, 2013. Upon roll call, motion was approved unanimously.

B. Daily Liquor License Permit Request VFW –Crusading for Kenny 9/14/13

Manager Cavallaro gave a brief overview explaining that the VFW is planning to do a private fundraising event, Crusading for Kenny, to take place on Saturday, September 14, 2013. He said it is Staff's recommendation to limit the area for outdoor alcohol consumption to the VFW parking lot only, and not allow the street closure, which the VFW had requested.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Special Event Application and Daily Liquor Permit Request for the event Crusading for Kenny on September 14, 2013 without the closure of Oregon Avenue. Upon roll call, motion was approved unanimously.
