

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Nelson, Commissioners Yuscka and Hanley. Also present were Village Manager Cavallaro, Chief Wieteska and five people in the audience.

III. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Class B Liquor License Application
Starbucks Coffee – 203 N. Eighth Street

Manager Cavallaro said that an application for a Class B liquor license has been received from Starbucks Coffee, located at 203 N. Eighth Street. He said Starbucks is seeking to expand their “Starbucks Evenings” concept at this location. He said the concept includes additional premium food items, as well as select craft beer and wine options for consumption on premises.

Ms. Carrie Bock, General Manager, explained that Starbuck’s policies with respect to liquor sales and service are that all alcoholic beverages will be stored behind the service counter and not accessible by customers. Service will be limited to one service per identification. She said signs will be posted at the exit prohibiting alcohol beyond the exit door and that alcoholic beverages will not be permitted on the outdoor patio.

Kelly Tadleman, District Manager, said all serving employees will be 21 or over and will be Bassett certified. She said employees under 21 have been transferred to other Starbuck locations.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to adopt the Finding of Fact as presented and issue a Class B liquor license for Coffee House Holdings, Inc. for the establishment known as Starbucks Coffee at 203 N. Eighth Street, pursuant to the conditions noted. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

B. Daily Liquor Permit Application
The Chubby Bullfrog-Oktoberfest – September 26, 2015

Manager Cavallaro said this is the second annual Oktoberfest put on by Chubby Bullfrog and the event will include a raffle benefitting the FISH Food Pantry.

Manager Cavallaro said it is Staff’s recommendation to further scale back the music and require it to end by 10:00 pm promptly. He said the 11:00 pm daily liquor license end time is recommended as a buffer to facilitate the full disbursement of the patrons.

Manager Cavallaro said that the stage is proposed to be oriented such that sound amplification will be oriented will be directed away from the Tartans Glen residential neighborhood.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit Request for the Chubby Bullfrog Oktoberfest event to be held on Saturday, September 26, 2015 subject to outdoor music amplification to cease by 10:00 pm. Upon roll call, motion was approved.
