

LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 6:45 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Nelson and Commissioner Yuscka. Commissioner Hanley arrived at 6:48 pm. Also present were Village Manager Cavallaro, Village Attorney Brechin and two (2) people in the audience.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. February 19, 2015

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Chairman Nelson to approve the Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes of February 19, 2015. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Video Gaming License Fee Credit
Blue Line Bar & Grill, 801 Wesemann Drive

George Othon addressed the Commission requesting that the payment that has been made to the Village for their Video Gaming License and Registration for the 2014/15 license year be applied as a credit for 2015/16. He said that he has yet to receive their State Gaming License which has been delayed for reasons beyond their understanding.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to authorize a \$2000 credit of monies paid by Blue Line Bar & Grill during the 2014/15 video gaming license year, to be applied toward the establishment's 2015/16 Video Gaming Registration and License fees. Upon roll call, motion carried.

B. May 1, 2015 Video Gaming License Renewal Application

Manager Cavallaro said that the applications have been received and are complete with documentation and appropriate payment for renewal of Video Gaming Licenses for the period May 1, 2015 to April 30, 2016.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the renewal of Video Gaming Licenses as submitted for Bikini Bottom Bar & Grill, Chubby Bullfrog Bar & Grill, Frank's Star (Dylan's Pub), Maxwell's Hot dogs, VFW Post 2298 and Village Squire for the period of May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016. Upon roll call, motion carried.

C. May 1, 2015 Liquor License Renewal Applications

Manager Cavallaro said that the applications have been received with documentation and appropriate payment for renewal of Liquor Licenses for the period May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016. He said approval for Bootlegger's Pub and Kitchen for outdoor dining (Class E) is outlined in a separate memo and that Chubby Bullfrog has not included payment to renew their existing Class E license for outdoor dining.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend that liquor licenses renewals for the period May 1, 2015 through April 30, 2016 as described in Manager Cavallaro's memo, dated April 17, 2015 be approved.

**D. Class E Liquor License Application
Bootleggers Kitchen & Pub, 629 S. Eighth Street**

Manager Cavallaro said that Bootlegger is requesting a Class E license for 5 tables or less. He said that the furnishings for the outdoor dining area have not yet been chosen or approved by the Village.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to issue a Class E liquor license to Bootleggers Kitchen and Pub located at 629 S. Eighth Street, subject to submittal, review and approval of outdoor dining furnishings.

V. MISCELLANEOUS:

Commissioner Hanley inquired about liability with outdoor dining on Village property and asked if patrons are allowed to bring their dogs with them, when they use outdoor dining facilities.

Manager Cavallaro said he would look to see if the Kane County had any regulations prohibiting this, but did say that the trend is in that direction.

Chairman Nelson said he received a letter from Starbucks to serve liquor under a concept called Starbucks Evenings. Manager Cavallaro said he would contact Starbucks and bring back specifics.

VI. ADJOURNMENT:

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to adjourn the Local Liquor Control Commission meeting. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.
