

Minutes of the West Dundee
Police and Fire Commission special meeting held
Tuesday, April 8, 2014

1. Meeting Called to order at 7:07 p.m.

6. Old Business;

A. Fred Kleeburg met with Chief Wieteska and Captain Riggle on February 19, 2014 to discuss “preference points” for part-time employees focusing on West Dundee part-time officers and Public Safety Officers. Some ideas discussed;

1. Further researching 5/10-2.1-8 Veteran’s and educational preference.

2. Adding language for preference (up to 10 points?) on Chief’s recommendation based on documentation (performance and assessment). Fred will check with John Broihier (atty for IPFCA) for recommendation on language.

3. Interviewing all candidates with passing scores on the written exam.

4. Adding part-time employees to oral interview list as long as they achieve a minimum passing score on the written exam.

B. Based on research and recommendation after the meeting February 19, 2014, the following is proposed;

1. By using the existing language of 5/10-2.1-8, the code already authorizes the commission to move part-time or full-time candidates who certified police officers in the state of Illinois to the top of the eligibility list. This adjustment occurs after the scoring of the written and oral examinations, and after awarding other preference points such as educational and military.

2. The commission will conduct oral interviews as indicated on the fact sheet provided at the orientation preceding the written examination.

3. Submit amended Article C to the Village Board for approval at the next available Board meeting.
