

**LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION**

**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

**II. ROLL CALL:**

Present were Chairman Nelson, and Commissioners Yuscka and Hanley. Also present were Village Manager Cavallaro and Village Attorney Brechin.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**A. July 14, 2014**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to approve the Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes of July 14, 2014. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. Daily Liquor Permit Request: VFW-Pig Roast, August 9, 2014**

Manager Cavallaro said that this is the VFW's annual Pig Roast and they are applying for a Daily Liquor Permit for the event scheduled for August 9, 2014 from 2pm to 10pm.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve a Daily Liquor Permit Request for VFW Post 2298 located at 117 S. First Street for the Annual Pig Roast to be held on Saturday, August 9, 2014. Upon roll call motion was approved.

**B. Daily Liquor Permit Request: VFW-Warner Wedding Reception, August 16, 2014**

Manager Cavallaro said the VFW is also applying for a Daily Liquor Permit for a private wedding reception on August 16, 2014. He explained that this event will allow for the outdoor consumption of alcohol from 10 am to 10 pm.

Both events will be held within the fenced in area which includes the VFW parking lot and the section of Oregon Avenue adjacent to the parking lot, requiring the closure of the street. The VFW has also requested the use of Public Works barricades and snow fencing for the event. Manager Cavallaro said the VFW is aware that this is their third and fourth request and they are permitted only 6 requests per year.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to approve a Daily Liquor Permit Request for VFW Post 2298, located at 117 S. First St. for the Warner Wedding Reception to be held on Saturday. August 16, 2014. Upon roll call. Motion was approved.

**C. Daily Liquor Permit Request: Heritage Fest, September 12, 13 & 14, 2014**

Manager Cavallaro said this is for the Village's annual Heritage Fest which establishes the restrictions as to where alcohol can be consumed. He said wristbands will be issued to those presenting legal identification of age 21 or above.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve a Daily Liquor License for Heritage Fest on September 12, 13 and 14, 2014. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**V. MISCELLANEOUS:**

Commissioner Hanley inquired if the hours for the liquor license for Heritage Fest could be extended until 11:30, as there is still a number of people at the festival at that time. It was decided to extend the hours on the liquor license to 11:30 on Friday and Saturday, but still have last call for purchase of beer and wine at 10:30 pm.

Commissioner Yuscka asked about Emmett's liquor license for Heritage Fest. Attorney Brechin said Emmett's can request a rider to their Insurance Policy for off-site consumption of alcohol.

Manager Cavallaro said that Fast & Easy Quick Mart closed ten (10) days ago.

**VI. ADJOURNMENT:**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to adjourn the Local Liquor Control Commission meeting. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.
