III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. April 16, 2018

Commissioner Yuscka noted a correction to the minutes, in that the Motion to adjourn was made by himself, not Commissioner Hanley.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Chairman Nelson to approve the Minutes of the April 16, 2018 Business Licensing Commission. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Massage Clinic License Violation Hearing Continued – The Relax Place, 1410 Spring Hill Mall

Attorney Binninger invited Mr. Geoff Gist, attorney for The Relax Place, to present his client's position to the Commission.

Attorney Binninger noted that the recommended order is as follows:

1. That the Licensee shall renew its massage therapy clinic license for that portion of 1410 Spring Hill Mall which shall include the rooms for massage and no massages shall be given on those premises except by a State licensed massage therapist. That portion of the premises with the massage therapy clinic license shall be clearly designed to distinguish that area from the area where Asian bodyworks are performed.
2. That the Licensee shall obtain a business license for its Asian bodyworks portion of 1410 Spring Hill Mall which shall include only Asian bodywork activities open to public view and with clients that do not have to disrobe but shall not include therapeutic massage requiring a Village Massage Therapy Clinic license.
3. That in the premises licensed as a Massage Therapy Clinic no minor under 18 years of age shall be allowed on the premises unless accompanied by a parent or guardian who shall remain in the room during a massage of the minor.

4. That a fine for the enforcement and hearing costs shall be imposed of \$750 and shall be paid within 30 days of the date of this order.

Chairman Nelson asked that the business owner apply for the required licenses by May 7, 2018, along with the name and state license of the licensed massage therapist(s) that will be on site, and a plan for the physical division of the space.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to accept the Final Order in the Matter of the Massage Therapy Clinic License of L.L. Health Center, Inc., DBA The Relax Place, at 1410 Spring Hill Mall (Hearing No. 01-18), as drafted and presented. Upon roll call, motion was approved.
