**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:17 pm.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. Daily Liquor Permit Request – Emmett’s Participation in Intelligentsia Cup Bike Race**

Manager Cavallaro said the event proposal called for local restaurants and businesses to participate in an Expo Area during the event, which will be held Wednesday, July 20, 2016.

Emmett’s Brewing Co. (128 W Main) has agreed to participate as a vendor for the sale of food and beverage items, including a selection of their craft beers.

Manager Cavallaro said beer would be available within a fenced in area, and signs would be displayed that say no alcohol is permitted beyond the designated special event area, to help ensure compliance with the Village’s ordinance prohibiting alcohol on public streets.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Chairmen Nelson to recommend approving the issuance of a Daily Liquor Permit to Emmett’s in conjunction with the Intelligentsia Cup Bike Race to be held on Wednesday, July 20, 2016 beginning at 10:30 am and ending no later than 8:30 pm. Upon roll call motion, was approved.
