**B. Class E Liquor License Application (Outdoor Dining)
Stanley's Restaurant & Tavern LLC, 629 S. Eighth Street**

He reiterated that under the recently amended guidelines, outdoor dining hours of operation are from 10:30 am to 10:30 pm.
