I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:26 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson, and Commissioners Andy Yuscka and Pat Hanley. Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro and Interim Police Chief Anthony Gorski.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. August 5, 2019

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the minutes of August 5, 2019 as presented. Upon roll call, motion was approved by voice vote.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Liquor Law Violation Hearing
John's Mobil, 551 S. Eighth Street

Manager Cavallaro said that John's Mobil has executed a Final Agreed Order in regards to a liquor law violation that occurred at his establishment.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to accept the Final Agreed Order as approved by Licensee on August 15, 2019, in the matter of the Class CCC Liquor License for HM Mobile Inc. DBA John's Mobil, 551 S. Eighth Street. Motion was approved upon roll call.

B. Video Gaming License Application
Dominick's Pizzeria, 735 S. Eighth Street

Manager Cavallaro said Dominick's Pizzeria, Inc. located at 735 S. Eighth Street has submitted an application for a video gaming license for the 2019/20 license year.

He added that the gaming license application has been completed and received along with payment.

Manager Cavallaro said Dominick's is proposing to utilize the services of Accel Entertainment Gaming, LLC as their terminal operator, and has provided a copy of the Illinois Gaming Board License for both the terminal operator and the establishment.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to adopt the Finding of Fact as presented and recommend the issuance of a video gaming license to Dominick's

Pizzeria, Inc. for three (3) video gaming devices to be located within the establishment at 735 S. Eighth Street. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**C. Consideration of New Liquor License Classification
Class L –Arts, Crafts & Entertainment Studio**

Manager Cavallaro said a new business called Trippots wishes to offer a concept similar to “paint and sip”. Trippots will offer an experience –based approach with “Show and Grow” DIY planting workshops and retail offerings, including plants and planting products, centered around a green living experience.

Manager Cavallaro said the Police Department surveyed paint and sip businesses in the area and it is evident from the reviews that the trend to offer beer and wine service is attractive to the customer base.

He added that the Police Department recommends a new Class L Liquor License classification with these specific restrictions.

- Annual fee of \$750;
- Restricted to beer and wine sales only;
- At an art studio arts and crafts school, or similar leisure/entertainment business;
- Limited to registered patrons assembled on the premises of business while conducting classes;
- Served by BASSET certified employees;
- Closing hours between the hours of twelve o’clock (12:00) AM and eight o’clock (8:00) AM.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend adoption of an Ordinance amending Title 3, Chapter 2 of the West Dundee Municipal Code, so as to amend 3-2-8- by adding a Classification L (Arts, Crafts & Leisure Entertainment). Upon roll call, motion was approved.
