

**LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION**

**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Commissioner Yuscka called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

**II. ROLL CALL:**

Present were Chairman Nelson, Commissioners Yuscka and Hanley.

Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro, and four (4) people in the audience.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**A. November 21, 2016**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Minutes of the November 21, 2016 Local Liquor Control Commission Meeting. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. Daily Liquor Permit Request - VFW Post 2298, 117 S First St  
Wedding Reception - June 24, 2017**

Manager Cavallaro noted that this request is very similar in nature to previous private events held at the VFW. He confirmed that this will be the VFW's first request for the 2017/18 license year that will begin on May 1.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit Request for VFW Post 2298, located at 117 S First Street, for the Robinson Wedding to be held on Saturday, June 24, 2017. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**B. Daily Liquor Permit Request - Emmett's Brewing Co., 128 W Main St  
Big Wheel Race - March 11, 2017**

Andy Burns of Emmett's provided an overview of the changes requested for this year's event, including the request to serve beer and limited liquor options in an enclosed area adjacent to the race site, from approximately 10 am until 4pm. Wristbands will be issued to anyone authorized to consume alcohol within this area. Mr. Burns stated that goal of providing alcohol consumption adjacent to the race is to minimize the instances of individuals bringing concealed alcoholic beverages to the event.

Emmett's has also requested to maintain an area for outdoor consumption of alcohol adjacent to their establishment, as an expansion of their existing outdoor patio. This would include enclosing the immediately adjacent parking spaces, as has been allowed during the past few years.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit Request for Emmett's, located at 128 W. Main Street, for the St.

Patrick's Day Celebration and Big Wheel Rally to be held on Saturday, March 11, 2017. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

Chairman Nelson noted that Starbucks has discontinued the sale of alcohol nationwide, including their location in West Dundee.
