I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:18 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson and Commissioner Pat Hanley. Commissioner Andy Yuscka was absent.

Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro, Police Chief Andrew Wieteska, Community Development Director Scott and five (5) people in the audience.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. May 7, 2018

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Chairman Nelson to table the minutes of May 7, 2018 until the next meeting.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

**A. Daily Liquor Permit Request Dundee Sports Bar
Alumni Basketball Shootout, June 23 & 24, 2018**

Manager Cavallaro said LifeZone360 is asking to conduct a special event, "Alumni Basketball Shootout", on Saturday June 23rd and Sunday, June 24th 2018, with the privilege of alcoholic beverage sales. The event would be conducted in the parking lot of the facility.

Both Community Development and the Police Departments have given their approval for this request.

Eric Samuelson, representing LifeZone360, said there will be a DJ and that the sound will be projected out towards Route 72 away from the residential area.

Police Chief Andy Wieteska said there were no complaints about the music from the last event held at that location.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Chairman Nelson to recommend issuance of a Daily Liquor Permit to Dundee Sports Bar, Inc. for the Alumni Basketball Shootout on Saturday, June 23rd and Sunday June 24th from 9:00 am to 8:00 pm, subject to payment of the permit fee of \$50 per day. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

B. Daily Liquor Permit Request – VFW Post 2298, Big Breakfast, May 27, 2018

Manager Cavallaro said the VFW has requested a Daily Liquor Permit for their “Big Breakfast” on the morning of Sunday, May 27, 2018, beginning at 8:00 am. The breakfast is being held in conjunction with the VFW Memorial Day Parade, which takes place later in the day.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Chairman Nelson to recommend issuance of a Daily Liquor Permit to VFW Post 2298 for their Big Breakfast on Saturday May 27, 2018, from 8:00 am to 11:30 am. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

C. Class B, D & F Expansion of Hours on Sundays

Manager Cavallaro said the VFW Post 2298 has requested consideration of earlier liquor sales hours for the Post on Sundays, beginning at 8:00 am.

He added that the Village in 2011, amended the Class A liquor license regulations to allow for liquor sales prior to 11:00 am on Sundays, based on a request to allow liquor service in conjunction with breakfast. He said the current Class A regulations allow for liquor sales beginning at 9:00 am on Sundays. He explained that this amendment was made based on a request specific to Class A licenses, and was not applied to all classifications.

Manager Cavallaro said the VFW is asking to amend the Class D liquor hours of operation to be consistent with Class A regulations, which allow for liquor service beginning at 9:00 am.

Manager Cavallaro said the following classifications would be amended to begin to be consistent with the Class A liquor licenses. These classifications are Class B, Class D and Class F.

He said the amended hours would go into effect immediately upon adoption of this ordinance, and amended Liquor Licenses for Dominick’s, Kabob Kitchen, VFW and Emmett’s would be issued.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Chairman Nelson to recommend adoption of an Ordinance amending Title 3, Chapter 2, Section 8: Liquor License Classifications of the West Dundee Municipal Code so as to allow liquor service beginning at 9:00 am on Sundays for Class B, D and F Liquor Licenses. Upon roll call, motion was approved.


V. MISCELLANEOUS: There was none.

VI. ADJOURNMENT:


