**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm.

**II. ROLL CALL:**

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson, and Commissioners Andy Yuscka and Pat Hanley.

Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro, Attorney Jim Binninger, Police Chief Andrew Wieteska and eleven (11) people in the audience.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**A. October 9, 2017**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to approve the Minutes of the October 9, 2017 Local Liquor Control Commission Meeting. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. Request to Extend Hours on Christmas Eve and New Years Eve, 2017 for Class C and Class CCC**

Manager Cavallaro said that Osco Drug, located at 1250-1260 W. Main Street is requesting that the hours for sale of alcoholic beverages begin at 8:00 AM on Sunday, December 24, 2017 and at 8:00 AM on Sunday, December 31, 2017 as these are their busiest days of the year. He explained that current regulations permit Sunday sales to begin at 10:00 AM for Class C and 12:00 PM for Class CCC Licenses.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to adopt an Ordinance providing for 8:00 AM opening hours for Class C and Class CCC liquor licenses on Sunday, December 24, 2017 and Sunday, December 31, 2017. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

**B. Daily Liquor Permit Requests – St. Catherine of Siena School – 845 W. Main Street Trivia Night, February 3, 2018 and Bingo, April 28, 2018**

Manager Cavallaro said that these two permits are for fundraising events at St. Catherine of Siena School for their annual Trivia Night on Saturday, February 3, 2018 and a Bingo event on Saturday, April 28, 2018. He said both events are scheduled to take place from 6-11 PM in the school gymnasium.

He stated that both events are restricted to participants age 21 and over and that the sale and consumption of alcohol will be limited to the school gym and concession area. He added that St. Catherine's has held numerous events involving liquor privileges and has a very positive history within the community in that respect.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit to St. Catherine of Siena School located at 845 W. Main, for Trivia Night on Saturday, February 3, 2018 and a Bingo event on Saturday, April 28, 2018. Upon roll call, Motion was approved.
