Manager Cavallaro said this is an application for Class A and Class E liquor Licenses for Woodfire to be located at 127 W. Main Street. He added that construction is near completion and the owners, Joe and Anne D’Astice hope to open the establishment within the next few weeks.

Manager Cavallaro said that a thorough review of the application has been conducted by the West Dundee Police Department and a recommendation for approval has been provided. He called the Commission’s attention to a number of items in the Finding of Fact including a requirement that an illustration of the proposed outdoor dining area and furniture proposed to be utilized needs to be submitted.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to adopt the Finding of Fact and authorize issuance of Class A and Class E liquor licenses to Woodfire Dundee, Inc., dba Woodfire, located at 127 W. Main Street, pursuant to satisfaction of the conditions and requirements noted in the Finding of Fact.




VI. ADJOURNMENT:
