

**LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION**

**I. CALL TO ORDER:**

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:15 pm.

**II. ROLL CALL:**

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson and Commissioners Pat Hanley and Andy Yuscka.

Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro, Attorney John Brechin and Police Chief Andrew Wieteska.

**III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:**

**A. August 22, 2016**

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Minutes of the August 22, 2016 Local Liquor Control Commission Meeting. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

**IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:**

**A. New Liquor License Classification – Class K Motion Picture Theatre**

Chief Wieteska advised that Cinemark approached the Village regarding the potential for a liquor license for their new theater facility at Spring Hill Mall.

As none of the existing liquor license classifications matched the business model of a motion picture theater, a survey of guidelines adopted by other municipalities was undertaken and a new license classification developed to address these specific operations. Chief Wieteska described some of the privileges and restrictions included in the classification.

Commissioner Hanley asked if patrons would be allowed to take alcohol outdoors. Chief Wieteska advised that this would not be allowed.

He added that Cinemark holds numerous liquor licenses throughout the country and has a very good track record in that regard. Once an appropriate classification is established by ordinance, it is expected that Cinemark will submit a liquor license application in short order.

**MOTION:** Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to support approval of an Ordinance amending Title 3, Chapter 2, so as to Amend 3-2-8 by adding Classification K (Motion Picture Theatre). Upon roll call, motion was approved.


