I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Keller called the meeting to order at 7:02 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Keller, and Commissioners Osth and Yuscka. Also present were Village Manager Cavallaro and Village Attorney Brechin. There was one (1) person in the audience.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. February 4, 2013

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Osth to approve the Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes of February 4, 2013.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Daily Liquor Permit Request - VFW Easter Bunny Breakfast

The VFW is requesting a daily liquor permit to accommodate their Easter Bunny Breakfast event on March 24, 2013 beginning at 8:00 am. The event is to take place outside of their regular hours pursuant to the Class D license, which allows for an 11:00 am start on Sundays.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Osth and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to approve the Daily Liquor Permit Request for the VFW Easter Bunny Breakfast to take place on March 24, 2013.

B. 2013/14 Liquor License Fees

Further to discussion on February 4, Manager Cavallaro noted that liquor license fees as a whole have not been increased since 1991 (22 years). The increases are minimal, and a liquor license fee survey shows that the amended fee amounts are on par with other area municipalities.

Trustee Osth noted that not-for-profit daily liquor permit fees would remain unchanged at \$50.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Osth to recommend an ordinance amending Title 3, Chapter 2, Alcoholic Liquor Regulations Section 3-2-9, License Fees and Number, of the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, effective for the 2013/14 license year.

V. MISCELLANEOUS:

Manager Cavallaro called the Commission's attention to a memo regarding Emmett's St. Patrick's Day celebration proposed for March 16, which addresses increased measures to ensure that alcohol remains within the designated area at all times.

Emmett's has requested to extend their patio area to include the sidewalk, parking area and northbound traffic lane on North Second Street, between the hours of 11:00 am and 5:00 pm. There was a general concern regarding closing the traffic lane and consensus to recommend to the Village Board the use of the parking area and sidewalk only.

VI. ADJOURNMENT:

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Osth and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to adjourn the Local Liquor Control Commission meeting. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.
