

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Nelson, Commissioner Yuscka and Commissioner Hanley. Also present were Village Manager Cavallaro and Village Attorney Brechin.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. September 8, 2014

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes of September 8, 2014. The motion was approved by unanimous voice vote.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Class A Liquor License Request
Blue Line Bar & Grill, 801 Wesemann Drive

Mr. George Othon, Crane Investment Holdings II, gave a brief history of Blue Line Bar & Grill. He explained that he is proposing an expansion of the physical layout of their concessions area, including a new full bar and restaurant area that will be located in the old training room in the north side of the building, as well as an additional bar on the mezzanine overlooking rinks 1 and 2. He said the mezzanine area is going to be a beer garden, mimicking the look of an ice rink, with boards and protective glass.

In answer to Commissioners questions, he said this will be a family area and that beer and wine will be served, but that wrist bands will be needed to purchase beer or wine. He also said the area will be monitored and all drinks must be consumed in that area.

He further explained that he is proposing to add four video gaming devices to be located against the west wall of the new bar area on the north side of the building. These devices will be set up in a contained area.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to adopt the Findings of Fact in Manager Cavallaro's memo dated October 31, 2014 and that a Class A liquor license be issued for Blue Line Bar & Grill. Upon roll call, motion was approved.

B. Video Gaming License Request-
Blue Line & Grill, 801 Wesemann Drive

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to adopt the Finding of Fact in Manager's Cavallaro memo of October 31, 2014, and issue a video gaming license for 4 machines for Blue Line Bar & Grill located at 801 Wesemann Drive. Upon roll call, motion was approved.
