

LOCAL LIQUOR CONTROL COMMISSION

April 16, 2018 – 6:30 pm

I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 6:42 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Christopher Nelson and Commissioner Andy Yuscka. Commissioner Pat Hanley was absent.

Also present were Village Manager Joseph Cavallaro and Village Attorney Jim Binninger.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Chairman Nelson to approve the Minutes of the January 22, 2018, February 19, 2018 and April 2, 2018 Local Liquor Control Commission. Motion was approved unanimously by voice vote.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Annual Liquor License Renewals May 1, 2018 - April 30, 2019

Manager Cavallaro noted the following items based on renewal applications: (1) Two additional Class E Licenses have been requested, for The Chubby Bullfrog and Bamboozels, (2) Route 31 Pantry and Liquors has requested a change in license classification for from a Class C to a Class CC license to allow for consumption on premises, (3) that the license for Bikini Bottom Bar is recommended for approval subject to a hearing to discuss excessive police contacts.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Chairman Nelson to approve renewal Liquor Licenses for the period of May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019 as noted in Manager Cavallaro's memo dated April 12, 2018, as follows:

Move to approve the renewal of **Class A** Liquor Licenses for Bamboozels, bleuroot, Blue Line Bar & Grill, Chili's Grill & Bar, Chipotle Mexican Grill, The Chubby Bullfrog Bar & Grill, Chunky Dog Bar & Grill, Dundee Sports Bar, Red Lobster and The Village Squire, subject to satisfaction of any outstanding license requirements.

Move to approve the renewal of a **Class A** license for Bikini Bottom Bar, subject to a hearing before the Local Liquor Control Commission regarding potential action against the license holder's liquor privileges due to the frequency, severity and volume of activities requiring police involvement at this location.

Move to approve the renewal of a **Class AA** Liquor License for RocHaus.

Move to approve the renewal of a **Class AAA** Liquor License for Olive Garden.

Move to approve the renewal of **Class B** Liquor Licenses for Dominick's Pizzeria, and Kabob Kitchens.

Move to approve the renewal of **Class C** Liquor Licenses for Dundee Supermart, Osco Drug, Route 31 Pantry and Liquors and Walgreens.

Move to approve the renewal of a **Class CC** Liquor License for Courtyard by Marriott.

Move to approve the renewal of **Class CCC** Liquor Licenses for Speedway and Thornton's.

Move to approve the renewal of a **Class D** Liquor License for VFW Post 2298.

Move to approve the renewal of **Class E** Liquor Licenses for bleuroot, Blue Line Bar & Grill, Emmett's Brewing Company, Kabob Kitchen and The Village Squire, and the approval of new Class E Liquor Licenses for Bamboozels and The Chubby Bullfrog, subject to satisfaction of any outstanding license requirements.

Move to approve the renewal of a **Class F** Liquor License for Emmett's Brewing Company.

Move to approve the renewal of a **Class G** Liquor License for Randall Oaks Golf Club.

Move to approve the renewal of a **Class K** Liquor License for Cinemark.

Upon roll call, motion was approved.

B. Annual Video Gaming License Renewals May 1, 2018 - April 30, 2019

Manager Cavallaro noted that the only change of note is an increase in the number of gaming devices in services at the VFW, up from 3 to 5.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Chairman Nelson to approve the renewal of Video Gaming Licenses as submitted for Bamboozels, Bikini Bottom Bar & Grill, Blue Line Bar & Grill, Chubby Bullfrog Bar & Grill, Chunky Dog Bar & Grill, Dundee Sports Bar, Kabob Kitchen, Tri-Cities VFW Post 2298 and The Village Squire for the period of May 1, 2018 through April 30, 2019.


V. MISCELLANEOUS: There was none.
