I. CALL TO ORDER:

Chairman Nelson called the meeting to order at 7:22 pm.

II. ROLL CALL:

Present were Chairman Nelson, Commissioner Yuscka and Commissioner Hanley. Also present were Village Manager Cavallaro and Village Attorney Brechin.

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

A. August 18, 2014

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to approve the Local Liquor Control Commission Minutes of August 18, 2014. The motion was approved by unanimously.

IV. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION:

A. Daily Liquor Permit Request - Chubby Bullfrog - Tartans Crossing Oktoberfest, October 4, 2014

Mike Morrison of The Chubby Bullfrog presented this request to the Commission. He noted that the event is a fundraiser for the F.I.S.H. Pantry, with \$1 donation for entry. Activities will include a live band, kids' activities, Oktoberfest inspired food and beverages including beer and wine, and sidewalk sales-style presentations from the businesses in the center. The area in which alcohol will be consumed will be fenced in and service will be provided by The Chubby Bullfrog's staff.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Hanley and seconded by Commissioner Yuscka to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit Request for The Chubby Bullfrog, located at 1959 Huntley Road, for the Tartans Crossing Oktoberfest event to be held on Saturday, October 4, 2014. Upon roll call motion was approved.

B. Daily Liquor Permit Request -VFW Honor Flight, October 11, 2014

Manager Cavallaro advised that the VFW Post is hosting a fundraiser for the Honor Flight organization, which brings veterans to Washington D.C. to view the war memorials. The area in which alcohol will be consumed will include the VFW parking lot, which will be fenced off. Alcohol will be served indoors by VFW staff. The VFW has held many such events with no incidents. This request is the 5th Daily Liquor Permit Request for the VFW this licensing year; The limit is 6 per licensing year.

MOTION: Moved by Commissioner Yuscka and seconded by Commissioner Hanley to recommend approval of a Daily Liquor Permit Request for VFW Post 2298, located at 117 S First Street, for the VNC Honor Flight event to be held on Saturday, October 11, 2014. Upon roll call motion was approved.
