

ORDINANCE 2021-09

An Ordinance Providing a Provisional Amendment to the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Illinois of 2004, as Amended, to Amend the 2020-2021 and 2021-2022 Liquor and Video Gaming License Terms, and Extend the Deadline for 2021-2022 Renewal Applications

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019/COVID-19 public health crisis and attendant measures taken to protect the public health have created an economic challenge for Village businesses; and

WHEREAS, in order to provide additional time for submittal of applications for Liquor License and Video Gaming License renewals for the 2021-2022 licensing year, the Village is providing a one-time extension of the 2020-2021 Liquor and Video Gaming Licenses to May 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the 2021-2022 license year is therefore amended to provide a start date of June 1, 2021, with the license year ending on April 30, 2022.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That a provisional amendment be made to the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Title 3, Chapter 2: Alcoholic Liquor Regulations, due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 / COVID-19 as follows:

- 1) One-time extension of time for the filing of the annual Liquor License renewal applications for the 2021-2022 licensing year.
 - a) Filing of all Liquor License renewal applications set forth in Section 3-2-4E, typically required to be filed between March 1 and April 1, shall be extended by the Village of West Dundee to May 10, 2021.
 - b) Consideration of all Liquor License renewal applications set forth in Section 3-2-5A, typically considered by the Local Liquor Control Commission on the third Monday in April, will be considered by the Local Liquor Control Commission on the third Monday in May, 2021.
- 2) One-time amendment to the full term for alcoholic Liquor Licenses for the 2021-2022 licensing year.
 - a) The full term for alcoholic Liquor Licenses set forth in Section 3-2-4E and 3-2-10A, typically May 1 through April 30, shall be amended by the Village of West Dundee to June 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022.

Section 2: That a provisional amendment be made to the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Title 3, Chapter 1, Section 4: Applications, and Title 6, Chapter 1, Section 18: Video Gaming, due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 / COVID-19 as follows:

- 3) One-time extension of time for the filing of the annual Video Gaming License renewal applications for the 2021-2022 licensing year.

- a) Filing of all Video Gaming License renewal applications, typically required to be filed between March 1 and April 1, shall be extended by the Village of West Dundee to May 10, 2021.
 - b) Consideration of all Video Gaming License renewal applications, typically considered by the Local Liquor Control Commission on the third Monday in April, will be considered by the Local Liquor Control Commission on the third Monday in May, 2021.
- 4) One-time amendment to the full term for Video Gaming Licenses for the 2021-2022 licensing year.
- a) The full term for Video Gaming Licenses, typically May 1 through April 30, shall be amended by the Village of West Dundee to June 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022.

Section 3: That renewal documentation for Liquor, Video Gaming and Tobacco Licenses are required to be submitted in their completed form by no later than May 10, 2021, with the exception of said payments, which will be due by no later than October 31, 2021.

In all other respects, Liquor and Video Gaming License policies remain unchanged and all Liquor and Video Gaming License holders are expected to continue to remain in compliance with state and local law and ordinances in terms of said licenses issued by the Village of West Dundee.


Section 5: That all ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict repealed.


Section 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force as provided by law and after publication in pamphlet form pursuant to the authority of the Board of Trustees.
