

ORDINANCE 2017-33

An Ordinance Authorizing Sale or Trade of Surplus Vehicles Village of West Dundee

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 (Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statues) provides that when, in the opinion of a simple majority of the corporate authorities holding office, it is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interest of the Village to own certain personal property, then said corporate authorities may, by ordinance, authorize the sale or disposition of that personal property in such a manner they may designate, and:

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 of the Illinois Compiled Statues, the President of Board of Trustees find that the vehicles listed below owned by the Village of West Dundee are no longer useful to the Village and the best interest of the Village will be served by the sale or trade of said vehicles:


2004 Ford Crown Victoria 4-Door Sedan	VIN 2FAFP71W35X108015

Section 2: Pursuant to said section 5/11-76-4, the Village Manager, or his designee, may dispose of such vehicle in such a manner as he deems appropriate.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
