

**ORDINANCE 2018-12**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 2, SECTION 8,  
LIQUOR LICENSE CLASSIFICATIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE  
VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS**

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality as contemplated under article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes Chapter 235 ILCS Article IV under the Illinois Liquor Control Act which has expressly conferred certain powers on municipalities with regard to the issuance of retail liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, VFW Post 2298 seeks to improve daily operations to allow service of alcoholic beverages for breakfast or brunch on Sundays, within the Class D Liquor License classification; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee has reviewed the request, and has identified the need to amend the Class B, D and F license classifications to allow for on-premises consumption of alcohol beginning at 9:00 am on Sundays.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated in this Section One as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Title 3, Businesses and Licenses, Chapter 2: Liquor Control, Section 8: License Classifications is hereby amended by repealing the following subsections in their entirety and enacting the following in lieu thereof:

Section 3-2-8-D: Class B License

1. Regulations: Licenses for establishments dispensing beer and wine only for consumption on the premises, whether served with meals in restaurants, taverns, hotels, motels, inns or eating establishments, at retail, having one or more service bars.
2. Closing Hours: Class B licensed premises shall not be open to the public Mondays through Saturdays between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. and on Sundays between the hours of one o'clock (1:00) A.M. and nine o'clock (9:00) A.M.

Section 3-2-8-H: Class D License

1. Regulations: Licenses for establishments identified as a club, organized not for profit, dispensing alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises.
2. Closing Hours: Class D licensed premises shall not be open to the public Mondays through Saturdays between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight and six o'clock (6:00) A.M. and on Sundays between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and nine o'clock (9:00) A.M.

Section 3-2-8-J: Class F License

1. Regulations: Licenses for establishments dispensing alcoholic liquors for consumption on the premises and engaged in the actual brewing and production of beer on the premises and for the dispensing of beer that has been brewed and produced on site for consumption off the premises and in packaged form only. This license shall be issued only to establishments with a microbrewery having meal service, and a restaurant capacity of not less than one hundred (100) seats.
2. Closing Hours: Class F licensed premises shall not be open to the public Mondays through Thursdays between the hours of one o'clock (1:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M., on Fridays and Saturdays between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M., and on Sundays between the hours of one o'clock (1:00) A.M. and nine o'clock (9:00) A.M.


Section 5: That all ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict repealed.


Section 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law and after publication in pamphlet form pursuant to the authority of the Board of Trustees.
