

ORDINANCE 2020-15

An Ordinance Amending the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Illinois of 2004, as Amended, Providing a Provisional Amendment to Liquor License and Video Gaming License Applications and Fee Payments for the 2020-2021 License Year

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes Chapter 235 ILCS Article IV under the Illinois Liquor Control Act which has expressly conferred certain powers on municipalities with regard to the issuance of retail liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, on March 16, 2020, Illinois Governor J.B. Pritzker signed Executive Order 2020-07 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 5) which mandated that all businesses in the State of Illinois offering food or beverages for onsite consumption, including restaurants, bars, grocery stores, and food halls, must suspend service for and may not permit on-premises consumption from March 16, 2020 through March 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 20, 2020, Governor Pritzker issued Executive Order 2020-10 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 8) that, among other things, issued a stay at home order for state residents and has restricted the operations of non-essential businesses effective through April 7, 2020 and mandates that all public and private gatherings in the State of Illinois of ten people or more are generally prohibited for the duration of the Gubernatorial Disaster Proclamation; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, Governor Pritzker issued Executive Order 2020-18 (COVID-19 Executive Order No. 16) that, among other things, extended the suspension of on-premises consumption of food or beverages at restaurants, bars, grocery stores, and food halls, the stay at home order for state residents, the restrictions on operations of non-essential businesses, the mandate regarding public and private gatherings, effective through April 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Coronavirus Disease 2019/COVID-19 public health crisis and attendant measures taken to protect the public health have created an economic challenge for Village businesses; and

WHEREAS, in order to allow the Village's businesses to maintain funds for operating capital in the short-term and provide relief with economic challenges, the Village is providing for a one-time extension of the time for payment of fees and a twenty five percent (25%) reduction in the amount of fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS:

Section 1: That a provisional amendment be made to the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Title 3, Chapter 2: Alcoholic Liquor Regulations, due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 / COVID-19 as follows:

- 1) One-time extension of time for payment of the annual Liquor License fees.
 - a) Payment of all Liquor License fees set forth in Section 3-2-9, typically due by May 1, shall be extended and shall be paid to the Village of West Dundee by October 31, 2020.

- 2) One-time reduction in the amount of the annual Liquor License fees.
 - a) Said Liquor License fees shall be reduced by twenty-five percent (25%) for amounts owed for the 2020-2021 license year.

Section 2: That a provisional amendment be made to the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Title 3, Chapter 1, Section 9: License Fee Schedule, due to Coronavirus Disease 2019 / COVID-19 as follows:

- 1) One-time extension of time for payment of the annual Video Gaming License fees.
 - a) All Video Gaming License fees set forth in Section 3-1-9, typically due May 1, shall be extended and shall be paid to the Village of West Dundee by October 31, 2020.

Section 3: That renewal documentation for Liquor, Video Gaming and Tobacco Licenses are required to be submitted in their completed form by no later than July 1, 2020, with the exception of said payments, which will be due by no later than October 31, 2020.

In all other respects, Liquor and Video Gaming License policies remain unchanged and all Liquor and Video Gaming License holders are expected to continue to remain in compliance with state and local law and ordinances in terms of said licenses issued by the Village of West Dundee.


Section 5: That all ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict repealed.


Section 6: That this Ordinance shall be in full force as provided by law and after publication in pamphlet form pursuant to the authority of the Board of Trustees.
