

ORDINANCE NO. 10-04

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE # 09-30 ESTABLISHING THE TAX LEVY OF THE SPECIAL SERVICE AREA #4 WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS FOR TAX LEVY YEAR 2009 FOR A MAXIMUM OF TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, did on September 24 2001 adopt Ordinance # 01-31 which created the Established of Special Service Area #4 within the Village of West Dundee; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this Special Service Area is to provide special municipal services to certain properties within the Village in the form of:

-Maintenance, repair, replacement and operation of the open space within the Carrington Reserve community designated as Lot A on the Final Plat of Subdivision for The Enclave at Carrington Reserve and as designated as Lot A on the Final Plat of Subdivision for the Timbers and Valleys at Carrington Reserve; and

WHEREAS, there is provided by the terms of said Ordinance, the imposition of an additional tax to repay the Village of West Dundee for this work performed; and

WHEREAS, the said services will be funded by the levy of an annual tax not to exceed the annual rate of .2 percent per annum of the assess value, as equalized, of the property in the Special Service Area #4 and

WHEREAS, on December 7, 2009, the Village Board of the Village of West Dundee adopted Ordinance No. 09-30 which levied the sum of fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000.00) for tax levy year 2009; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 09-30 was filed with the Kane County Clerk's Office as stipulated by State Statute; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the passage and the filing of Ordinance 09-30, it has been determined by the Village of West Dundee that there are adequate reserves to meet the on-going maintenance obligations as established in Ordinance #01-31 to reduce the 2009 tax levy amount from fifty-five thousand dollars (\$55,000.00) to twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000.00); and

WHEREAS, for tax levy year 2009, the Village of West Dundee is hereby levying for SSA #4 the sum of:

TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$25,000)

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee, Illinois as follows:

Section One: The Clerk of the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois is directed to file a certified copy of this Ordinance with the Clerk of Kane County, Illinois.

Section Two: This Ordinance shall be known as Ordinance No. 10- 04 and shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its passage and approval as required by law.


Section Three: If any section, paragraph, subdivision, clause, sentence or provision of the Ordinance shall be adjudged by any Court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, such judgement shall not affect, impair, invalidate or nullify the remainder thereof, which remainder shall remain and continue in full force and effect.

Section Four: PASSED by the Village Board of the VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, Kane County, Illinois and approved by me this 1st day of March, 2010.


