

**ORDINANCE 2013-04**

**An Ordinance Amending Title 7, Chapter 2, to add Section 7-2-2 Subsection O to the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Illinois, Prohibiting Parking On Unimproved Surfaces**

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality as contemplated under article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Village President and Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee believe and hereby declare that parking vehicles on unimproved surfaces should be prohibited in the Village due to appearance and safety concerns;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby incorporated in this Section One as if said recitals were fully set forth herein.

Section 2: A new Subsection O shall be and is hereby added to Title 7, Chapter 2 Section 2 of the West Dundee Municipal Code and read as follows:

**Sec. 7-2-2 O Parking Prohibited In Specific Places**

O. On any unimproved surface not consisting of Village of West Dundee approved asphalt, concrete, brick, or other similar impervious surface.


Section 3: Any policy, resolution or ordinance of city, or any part thereof, that conflict with the provisions of this ordinance shall be and is hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.


Section 4: The ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.
