



PROCLAMATION

Tri-Cities Little League Day Dedication, Pride and Teamwork

WHEREAS, the Tri-Cities Little League, a West Dundee-based non-profit organization providing baseball, softball, tee-ball and Challenger programs to youth from West Dundee, East Dundee, Carpentersville, Sleepy Hollow and Gilberts, has served our community for 64 years;

WHEREAS, the Tri-Cities Little League achieved a history-making 2017 season, as three teams won Division Championships: the Girls Softball Majors All-Stars, the Boys 10U All-Stars and the Boys 11U All-Stars; and

WHEREAS, the 10U and 11U Boys All-Stars both went on to win State Championships, representing the first time in the organization's history that two Tri-Cities teams have achieved this high honor in a single season; and

WHEREAS, a Tri-Cities Boys All-Stars team who won the Division 13 Championship in 2014 and went on to place second in the State Championship, was named State Champions in February of 2015 following the disqualification of their opponent; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee wishes to recognize the hard work and dedication exhibited by the players, coaches and families of the Tri-Cities Little League organization, and to celebrate and honor the significant achievements of these teams and the organization;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that I, Christopher J. Nelson, acting under and by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution of the State of Illinois and Laws of this Village of West Dundee, hereby proclaim **Friday, August 25, 2017** as
