

ORDINANCE 2018-32

An Ordinance Revising Title 7 Motor Vehicles and Traffic Chapter 1-14

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality as contemplated under article VII, Section 6, of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois;

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee Police Department has evaluated the following intersections:

- South Third Street at Dunning Avenue
- South Seventh Street at Dunning Avenue at Strom Drive at Ryan Lane;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 7-1-14 Traffic Control Devices, the Village of West Dundee President and Board of Trustees are authorized to regulate, warn or guide traffic pursuant to traffic warrants or criteria;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, THAT, pursuant to Section 7-1-14 of the West Dundee Municipal Code, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee authorize the installation of the following traffic control signage.

Section 1: That the following intersections are hereby designated as:

- South Third Street at Dunning Avenue – TWO-WAY STOP - North/South on South Third Street
- South Seventh Street at Dunning Avenue at Strom Drive at Ryan Ln – FOUR-WAY STOP


Section 2: That all ordinances and parts thereof in conflict herewith be, and the same are, repealed and are of no further force and effect.


