

## ORDINANCE 2010 -03

### An Ordinance Authorizing Sale or Donation of Fire Department Apparatus Surplus

WHEREAS, 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 (Chapter 65 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes) provides that when, in the opinion of a simple majority of the corporate authorities holding office, it is no longer necessary or useful to, or for the best interest of the Village to own certain personal property, then said corporate authorities may, by ordinance, authorize the donation of that personal property in such a manner they may designate, and:

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, that:

Section 1: Pursuant to 65 ILCS 5/11-76-4 of the Illinois Compiled Statutes, the President of Board of Trustees find that the vehicles listed below owned by the Village of West Dundee are no longer useful to the Village and the best interest of the Village will be served by the sale and / or donation of said surplus property.

One 1976 Howe/Gruman Fire Engine - Serial # 14702-H with 35,755 miles,

Section 2: Pursuant to said section 5/11-76-4, the Village Manager, or his designee, be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to sell and / or donate the surplus property in such a manner as he deems appropriate.

Section 3: This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval in the manner provided by law.

PASSED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, and approved by the President of said Village this 1<sup>st</sup> day of February, 2010.


