

FALL LEAF COLLECTION SCHEDULE

Village of West Dundee - *Effective November 13, 2017*

Public Works has amended the leaf collection schedule this week as a result of high leaf volume and wet weather. This week's schedule is as follows:

MONDAY - NOVEMBER 13

Old Town - South Side - North/South Streets

TUESDAY - NOVEMBER 14

Old Town - South Side - East/West Streets (Day 1)

WEDNESDAY - NOVEMBER 15

Old Town - South Side - East/West Streets (Day 2)

THURSDAY - NOVEMBER 16

Old Town - North Side (All)

FRIDAY - NOVEMBER 17

Tartans Glen and the Hills (All) *

(If possible, Fairhills and Old World will also be completed on Friday.)

The purpose of this schedule is to enable West Dundee residents and property owners to coordinate the placement of leaves on the street with the anticipated collection schedule for their location. This coordination attempts to minimize the length of time that leaves sit on the street, thereby mitigating such potential issues as clogged storm sewers and limited parking options.

Before placing leaves in the street, please check the current schedule, and place your leaves on the street as close as possible to the anticipated collection date for your area.

The Public Works Department generally anticipates making one full pass through the Village every week. However, this schedule is heavily dependent on weather conditions and the volume of leaves placed in the street for collection. With no precipitation and a moderate volume of leaves, the crew will move faster than the schedule above indicates. Alternatively, if there is rain and a high volume of leaves, it's possible that the entire Village may not be done in a single week. Potential for equipment damage or failures are another factor that can affect the schedule. Please check back for updates before placing leaves in the street.

Please review the [Fall Leaf Collection Guidelines](#) for more information about proper placement of leaves for collection. The Fall Leaf Collection Program continues until the last week of November, weather depending.

* Additionally, please be reminded that the Village code calls for waste containers to be placed on the tree bank/parkway in front of residential homes. To the extent that it is reasonable, we would ask that you do not place refuse containers in the street. This becomes increasingly important during the fall leaf collection season and the winter snow removal season, in terms of the Public Works gaining access to clear the streets of this material.
