

**ORDINANCE 2021-32**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 2,  
ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR REGULATIONS OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF  
THE VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, ILLINOIS OF 2004, AS AMENDED,  
AMENDING THE NUMBER OF ALLOWED LIQUOR LICENSES**

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes Chapter 235 ILCS Article IV under the Illinois Liquor Control Act which has expressly conferred certain powers on municipalities with regard to the issuance of retail liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, Uniq Wine & Spirits, Inc. applied for and was approved for issuance of a Class C liquor license on December 6, 2021, an adjustment has already been made to the number of allowed Class C licenses.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that

Section 1: The Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Title 3 Chapter 2, Alcoholic Liquor Regulations, Section 3-2-9 Number of Licenses, as amended, shall be, and the same hereby is amended by repealing in its entirety the said Section 3-2-9 and enacting the following Section 3-2-9 in lieu thereof:

*3-2-9: NUMBER OF LICENSES: There shall be allowed one (1) Class AAA License, one (1) Class AA License, twelve (12) Class A Licenses, two (2) Class B Licenses, four (4) Class C Licenses, one (1) Class CC License, four (4) Class CCC Licenses, one (1) Class D License, eight (8) Class E Licenses, one (1) Class F License, one (1) Class G License, zero (0) Class H Licenses, one (1) Class K License and one (1) Class L License.*

Section 3: That all ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force as provided by law and after publication in pamphlet form pursuant to the authority of the Board of Trustees.
