

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING TITLE 3, CHAPTER 1 AND 5 OF THE WEST DUNDEE
MUNICIPAL CODE OF ORDINANCES**

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois (the “*Village*”) is a duly organized and validly existing home-rule municipality created in accordance with the Constitution of the State of Illinois of 1970 and the laws of the State; and,

WHEREAS, the Village routinely utilizes its powers to ensure and protect the health, safety, and welfare of its residents, as prescribed in Article 7, Section 6(a) of the 1970 Constitution of the State of Illinois; and,

WHEREAS, expanding on the minimum standards established by the State of Illinois, the Village currently regulates the following activities: video gaming, gambling, amusement games, and raffles; and,

WHEREAS, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee find that it is in the best interests of the Village and its residents to define certain video gaming businesses and set the business registration fees therefor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, as follows:

Section 1. The recitals in the preambles to this Ordinance are incorporated into this Section 1 as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The Municipal Code is amended by deleting Section 3-5-2B.4. and replacing it with the following:

“4. It shall be unlawful for any person to operate as a video gaming terminal operator or video gaming terminal distributor within the corporate limits of West Dundee and distributing a video gaming device for use by any person or business for profit from the operation thereof, unless a license has been issued by the village and the license fee has been paid in full for the current year.”

Section 3. Section 3-1-94.D. of Title 3, Chapter 1 of the Municipal Code is hereby deleted in the entirety and replaced with the following:

“D. Other Licensee and Permit Fees: The license or permit for the following businesses, professions and occupations shall be subject to the license and permit fees as follows and not the general fee:

<u>TYPE OF LICENSE OR PERMIT</u>	<u>FEE</u>
Mechanical amusement device	\$135.00 per machine per year
Peddlers, solicitors, itinerant merchants. No license fee for a civic, charity, school or service organization	\$50.00 per day, \$200.00 per week \$500.00 per year
Video gaming establishment	\$50.00 per year
Video gaming terminal operator or distributor	\$1,000.00 per year per establishment plus \$250.00 per year for each gaming device distributed within the Village”


Section 4. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law.


