

**ORDINANCE 2011-01**

***An Ordinance Amending Title 3, Chapter 2, Alcoholic Liquor Regulations  
Section 3-2-9 Number of Licenses and for Section 3-2-8 License  
Classifications of the Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee,  
Illinois of 2004, as Amended***

WHEREAS, the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois is a home rule municipality as contemplated under Article VII, Section 6 of the Constitution of the State of Illinois, and the passage of this Ordinance constitutes an exercise of the Village's home rule powers and functions as granted in the Constitution of the State of Illinois; and

WHEREAS, the Illinois Compiled Statutes Chapter 235 ILCS Article IV under the Illinois Liquor Control Act which has expressly conferred certain powers on municipalities with regard to the issuance of retail liquor licenses; and

WHEREAS, a request of Dylan's to provide for earlier Sunday service hours in conjunction with breakfast; and

WHEREAS, upon recommendation of the Local Liquor Control Commission adjustments have been made to the annual fee for Class A Liquor licenses to account for the expanded hours; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the request from Dylan's, an increased allowance for liquor privileges for all Class A license holders beginning at 9:00 am on Sundays has been recommended.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES, VILLAGE OF WEST DUNDEE, KANE COUNTY, ILLINOIS that

Section 1: The Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Title 3 Chapter 2, Alcoholic Liquor Regulations Section 3-2-9 License Fees as amended, be, and the same hereby is amended by repealing in its entirety the said Title 3, Chapter 2, Section 3-2-9 and enacting the following Section 3-2-9 in lieu thereof:

Section 2: The Municipal Code of the Village of West Dundee, Title 3 Chapter 2, Alcoholic Liquor Regulations Section 3-2-8 License Classifications, subparagraph C, 2. Class A License to be amended, and the same hereby amended and by repealing in its entirety the said Title 3, Chapter 2, Section 3-2-8 Subparagraph C, 2. Closing Hours enacting the following Section 3-2-8 Subparagraph C, 2 Closing Hours in lieu thereof:

C.

2. Closing Hours: Class A licensed premises shall not be open to the public on Mondays between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00) midnight and six o'clock (6:00) A.M., Tuesdays through Fridays between the hours of one o'clock (1:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M., Saturdays between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and six o'clock (6:00) A.M., and on Sundays between the hours of two o'clock (2:00) A.M. and nine o'clock (9:00) A.M.

Section 3: That all ordinances, resolutions and orders, or parts thereof, in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are to the extent of such conflict repealed.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage and approval as provided by law and after publication in pamphlet form pursuant to the authority of the Board of Trustees.

PASSED by the Board of Trustees of the Village of West Dundee, Kane County, Illinois, and approved by the President of said Village this 7th day of February, 2011.




